

## User Report for Logiks General (Intermediate)

### The report

- Is confidential and intended for use only by trained test users.
- Has a shelf life of 12 months.

### The test

- Assesses an individual's general ability.
- Contains verbal, numerical and abstract questions, presented in three separately timed sections.
- Is item-banked, meaning that each respondent is presented with a different set of questions balanced for difficulty.

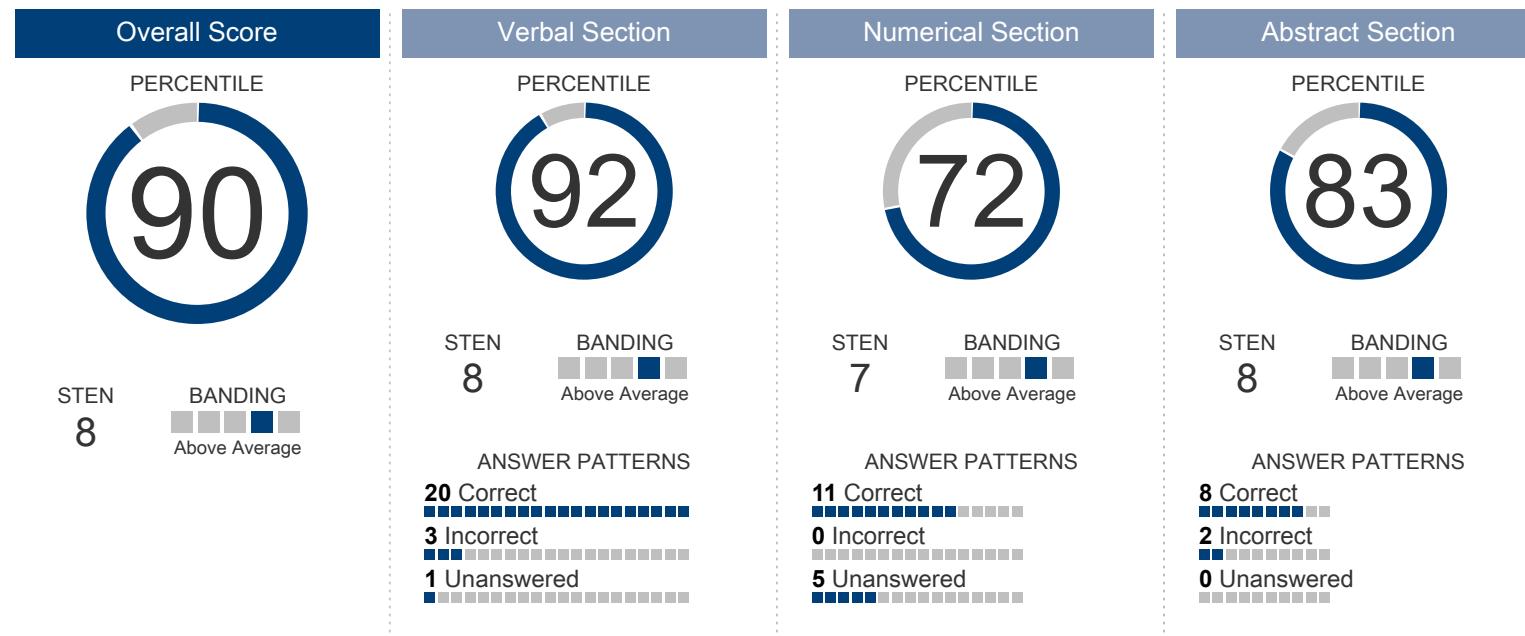
### Results

- Are compared with those obtained from a large group of people who have also completed this test (a norm group). The norm group used was Global (General) 1.0.
- Are displayed in percentiles (percentage of people in the norm group that the respondent has performed as well as or better than), stens (standardised scores presented on a 1-10 scale), and using a five-point banding ranging from well below average to well above average.
- Are subject to measurement error which means that the respondent's true, or actual, scores may be slightly higher or lower than those shown.

### Decision making

- Should be based on the overall score, in conjunction with other sources of information about the respondent where available and relevant.

Sample Candidate's overall score on the test was above average compared to the norm group. This suggests that Sample's general reasoning ability is better than that of most others in the comparison group. She is therefore likely to demonstrate high levels of mental agility in a variety of contexts.



### Speed and Accuracy

The Speed score is based on the number of questions attempted. The Accuracy score is based on the percentage of questions answered correctly out of the number attempted. The results suggest that Sample Candidate worked more quickly and accurately than most.
